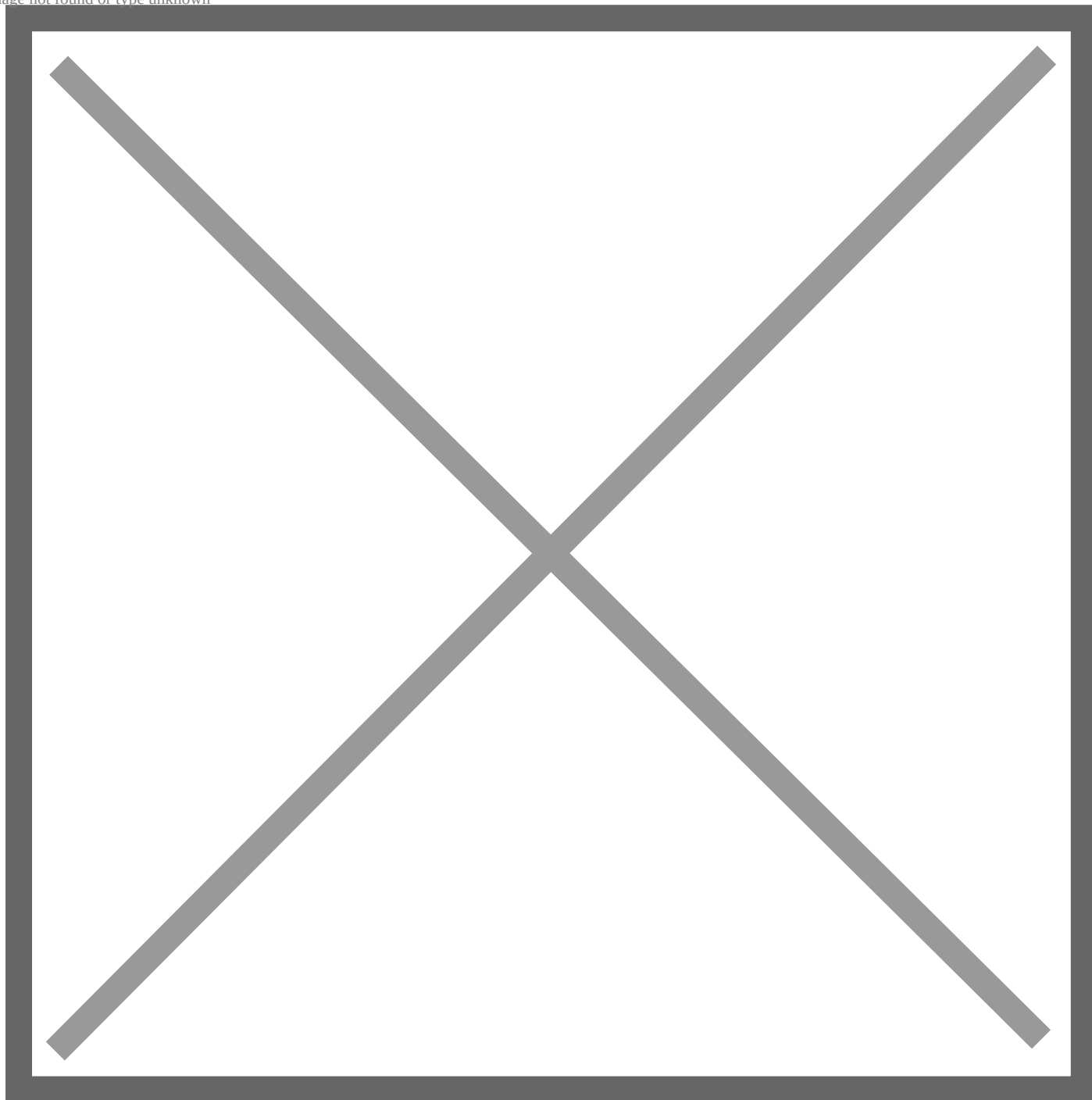


Toyota Appoints Jacqueline Thomas Group Vice President, Chief Compliance Officer
