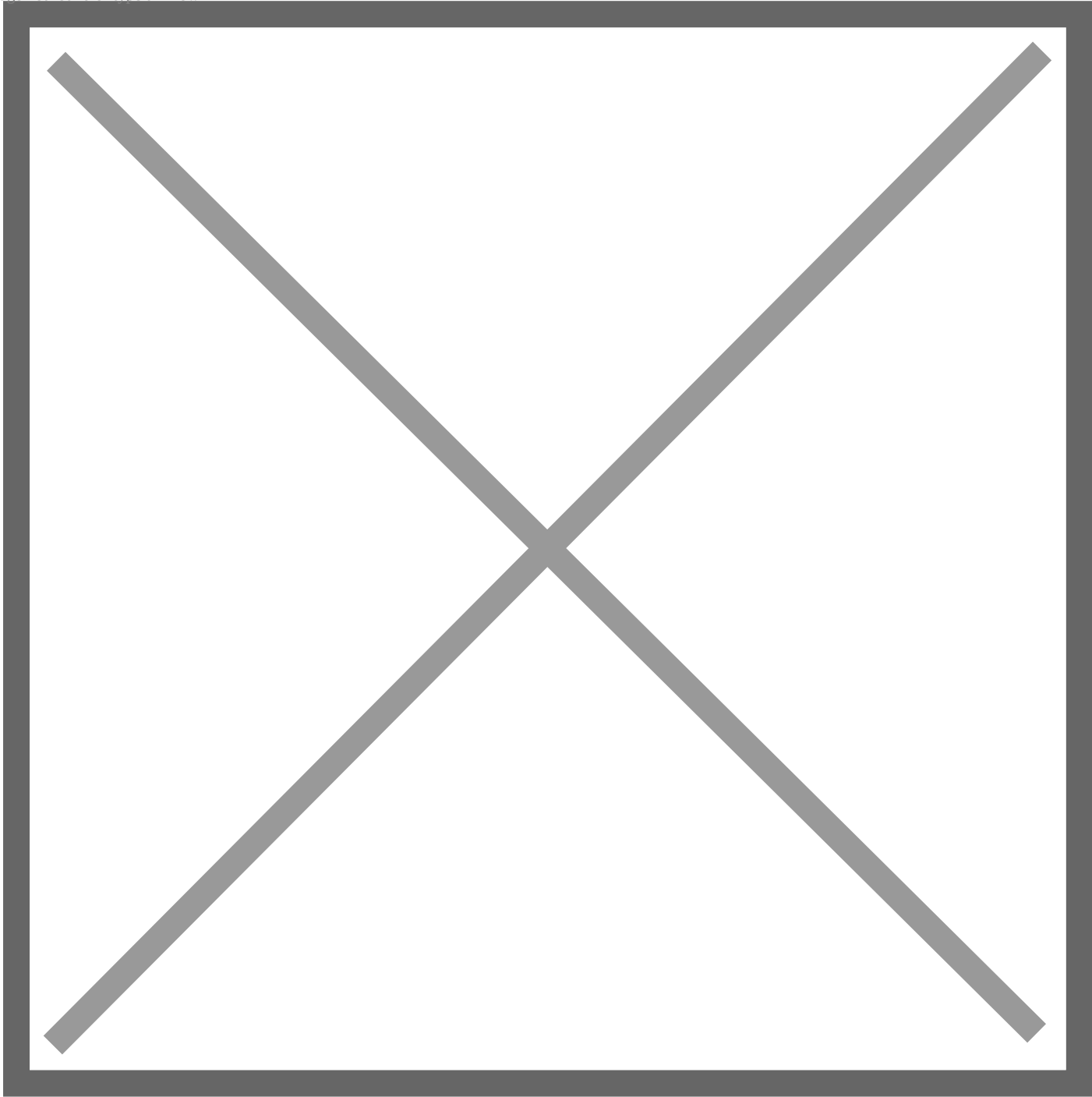


Toyota Adds Pro Golfer to Athlete Roster

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TORRANCE, Calif. (Nov. 14, 2013) – No stranger to adversity, professional golfer Lizette Salas has worked hard to earn her spot on the LPGA Tour.
