

New York Solar Flowers Bloom in Flatiron Plaza Display July 23 – August 2

The flowers are located on Flatiron Plaza, adjacent to the iconic Flatiron building as part of the launch of the 2010 Toyota Prius and they bring to life the theme: ?Harmony Between Man, Nature and Machine.?
