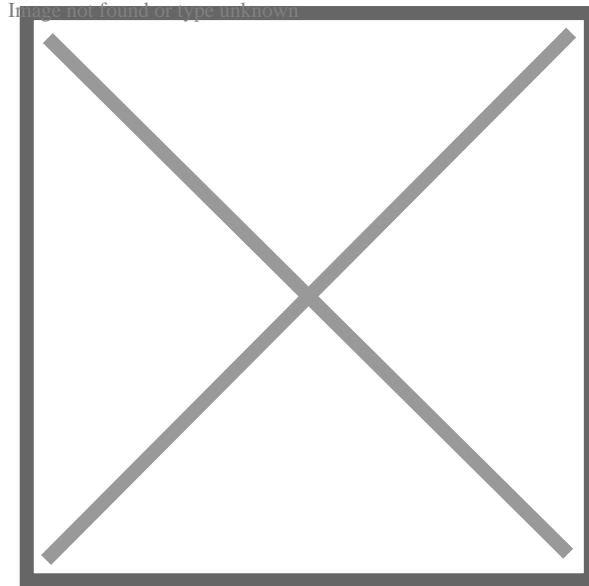


Tim Hollander
